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# IDC-BOHOL, PHILIPPINES

Before attending, you will receive the new IDC digital crewpak, with 16 eLearning sections, all geared towards preparing you for in class workshops and presentations. There are also some great study tools in the crewpak, such as the Diving Knowledge Workbook. This covers all Dive Theory subjects, Physics, Physiology, Decompression Theory, Equipment and Skills and Environment. Working your way through these before attending will prepare you for the Theory and workshop subjects we cover during the IDC.

## IDC-STEP 1 ONLINE PREP

We'll meet you online in our virtual classroom (video conference) to review the IDC curriculum presentations. 7 x 3 hour sessions in the evenings around your time zone. These are fun and highly interactive online sessions!

### IDC-STEP 2 IN WATER PREP

Together in Bohol, it's now time to jump in the water. Over 10 days, we'll fine tune your dive skills, practice confined & open water teaching presentations, rehearse knowledge development presentations and refresh your first aid teaching skills.

## IDC-STEP 3 INSTRUCTOR EXAM

A PADI Examiner will spend 2 days with you to evaluate your readiness to teach in the water and in the classroom. It's really just repeating what you already know in front of someone else!

# IDC - PREREQUISITES:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be certified as a Divernaster or equivalent.
- Be certified as a diver for a minimum of six months.
- Have 90 logged dives that include experience in night, deep and navigation. (100 needed for IE)
- Be fit for diving and submit a medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months.
- Have proof of CPR and First Aid training within the last 24 months (PADI EFR course meets this requirement).
