## Step 1 - online prep

Either attend the full 14 day IDC in-person, or we'll meet you online in our virtual classroom (video conference) to review the IDC curriculum presentations. 7 x 3 hour sessions around your time zone. These are fun and highly interactive online sessions!

## Step 2 - inwater section

Together on Koh Tao it's time to jump in the water. Over 8 days, we'll fine tune your dive skills, practice confined & open water teaching presentations, rehearse knowledge development presentations and refresh your first aid teaching skills.

## Step 3 - Instructor Exams

A PADI Examiner will spend 2 days with you to evaluate your readiness to teach in the water and in the classroom. It's really just repeating what you already know in front of someone else!

## Prerequisites

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be certified as a Divemaster or equivalent.
- Be certified as a diver for a minimum of six months.
- Have 100 logged dives that include experience in night, deep and navigation.
- Be fit for diving and submit a medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months.
- Have proof of CPR and First Aid training within the last 24 months (PADI EFR course meets this requirement).
