### Step 1 - online prep

### Step 2- inwater section

Together in Tulum, Mexico it's time to jump in the water. Over 8 days, we will fine tune your dive skills, practice confined & open water teaching presentations, rehearse knowledge development presentations and refresh your first aid teaching skills.

### Step 3 - Instuctor Exams

A PADI Examiner will spend 2 days with you to evaluate your readiness to teach in the water and in the classroom. It's really just repeating what you already know in front of someone else!

### Prerequisites

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be certified as a Divemaster or equivalent.
- Be certified as a diver for a minimum of six months.
- Have 100 logged dives that include experience in night, deep and navigation, before the IE.
- Be fit for diving and submit a medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months.
- Have proof of CPR and First Aid training within the last 24 months (PADI EFR course meets this requirement).
